### Some African Americans Listed in Mobile, Alabama City Directories 1837-1839, 1842, 1844

#### Introduction

City directories can be an excellent genealogical resource used to trace Americans of any ethnicity and are especially helpful because they may be obtainable when census records are not available. Directories are a list of residents and businesses in a particular locality in a particular year. They are useful in helping to reconstruct a community and might also provide some insight into living conditions.

It should be kept in mind, however, that not all city directories are alike. Some directories listed "colored people" in a separate section in the back. Other directories included African Americans, but may not have always identified them by race. Women business owners as well as widows and heads of households might also be included in the directories.

Although some early city directories included only the names of heads of household, a city directory might be divided into the following sections:

- a listing of streets;
- a listing of businesses, including advertisements for local businesses, products and services;
- an appendix that might include churches, schools, and charitable institutions, societies, fraternal organizations and clubs, banks, government offices, hospitals, cemeteries, asylums, names of community leaders and the organizations they are affiliated with, and orphanages.

Early Mobile, Alabama, city directories did contain the names of African Americans and usually included the occupations and an address. The absence of an occupation, however, does not mean that the individual was indigent, it merely means that the information was not available.

The following transcription may not include every free person of color because not all directory entries included a racial designation.

The directory included the following: (1) in the address section, "c." for corner and "b." for between; (2) in the race column, "c" for colored, "fwc/fmc" for free woman of color or free man of color and "fcm" for free colored man. Information enclosed in brackets [] has been inserted by the transcriber. The column headings have been inserted on each page.
